DESQUICIADO EL CORTE 2015

This wine is sourced from Gualtallary, Tupungato, in the heart of the Uco Valley. The Malbec is sourced from hillside vines on the edge of the vineyard. The soils profile is poor sandy, clay with excelente drainage. The Cabernet Franc comes from vines planted in a dry river bed, with very stony soil. The Merlot comes from a section in the vineyard with large boulders.

The blend of El Corte is 60% Malbec, 35% Cabernet Franc and 5% Merlot. The wine was made with many small microvinifications in plastic bins.

Malbec was fermented alone and the Cabernet Franc was cofermented with the Merlot. The wine was aged in 2nd use French barrels for 14 months.
